Parents and Guardians needed for the following positions:

S.L.T. (School Leadership Team): School Leadership Teams (SLTs) are vehicles for developing school-based educational policies, and ensuring that resources are aligned to implement those policies. SLTs assist in the evaluation and assessment of a school's educational programs and their effects on student achievement. SLTs play a significant role in creating a structure for school-based decision making, and shaping the path to a collaborative school culture. The SLT meets once a month from 4pm-6pm. This is where you can have an opinion as to what goes on in your child's school and with their Education. Get involved and be in the know. There are **2** open positions on the SLT for the new school year. Position term is for 2 years.

C.E.C. (Community Education Council): New York City's Community and Citywide Education Councils are charged with promoting student achievement, advising and commenting on educational policies, and providing input to the Chancellor and the Panel for Educational Policy on matters of concern to the district. CEC Meeting are the first Wednesday of every month at 7PM at 30-48 Linden Place.

P.C. (President's Council): A Presidents' Council is an organization of PA/PTA presidents (or designees) that represents the interests of parents, and parent leadership organizations. President's Council meets once a month to be determined at a later time.
