**Principal's Report:**

- QR went well. In 90 days it will be made public.
- School Report Cards will be out soon. We will discuss results at next meeting.
- Senator Vallone has awarded the school \$550,000.00 for auditorium renovations and \$300,000.00 for gymnasium renovations.
