2. Will the students be rotating classes?

Yes. Students will be moving to various classrooms throughout the day. For example, science may always be in room 307, while social studies may be in room 302.

4. How can students and families observe assignments and grades?

Students will have access to the NYC DOE GAMA system which will have all assignments and grades posted. Parents will also have access to this system through their NYSCA account.

7. **Is school breakfast and lunch free?**

Yes, currently breakfast and lunch are free.

8. **What is the school's protocol on bullying?**

All protocols are based on the NYC DOE Code of Conduct so interventions may vary depending on the nature of the case. However, a blend of parental outreach, guidance intervention, and disciplinary action may be expected.

9. **Will there be an early drop off? Start Time? Place?**

Drop off should be between 7:30-8:00 and each grade will have a specific line up area.

- Grade 6: 17th Rd entrance nearest playground, in large yard under hoops
- Grade 7: 17th Ave near closest to Clintonville
- Grade 8: 17th Ave main entrance

The school day begins at 8am.

10. **What is the school uniform policy?**

Shirts - Plain colored (no logo) T-shirts or collared shirt.

- 6th Grade - Black

Pants - Material - Khakis, Jeans, Sweats (no rips)

No Leggings

Color - any

Hoodies can only be school apparel

Regular non-hooded sweatshirts may be worn over uniform shirts but need to be plain and in proper grade color as shirts.

11. **When will Metro-Cards be given out and who is eligible?**

Metro will most likely be provided by the 2nd day of school, but is dependent on when the NYC DOE distributed them to the school.

12. **What arts do you offer during the school day?**

Students will most likely be taking foreign language and technology in sixth grade. They will then have a choice between visual arts, film & media, or dance as their choices in 7th and 8th grade.

13. **Is there an honors program for children entering the 6th grade?**

Yes. Honors class placement is based on NYS test scores, report card grades, and alternative assessments like iREADY or Acadience. Space limitations may vary depending on various factors from year to year. For example, there are 3 honors classes in sixth grade and 3 honors classes in 7th grade this year.

14. **Are there lockers located in the school? If not, where do students store their belongings?**

There are no lockers for children, but there are homerooms. Each homeroom has closets which students may use to hang up their coats and store items like umbrellas. Closets are locked and students will retrieve their belongings during pm homeroom at the end of the day.

15. **When and how will my child know what class they were assigned to?**

Classes are determined prior to the first day of school. Families receive a letter in the mail with that information
